### **MOUNT PEARL MUNICIPAL PLAN AMENDMENT # 77, 2010 MOUNT PEARL DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENT #200, 2010 (#5 CENTENNIAL STREET REDESIGNATION AND REZONING AMENDMENT)**

City Council adopted Municipal Plan Amendment No. 77, 2010 and Development Regulations Amendment No. 200, 2010 on June 15, 2010. A Public Hearing to consider objections and representations on these amendments will be held at 7:00 pm, July 6, 2010 at City Hall.

The purpose of Municipal Plan Amendment No. 77, 2010 is to amend the municipal plan map from City Centre to Mixed Use. The purpose of Development Regulations Amendment No. 200, 2010 is to amend Schedule "E", Land Use Zoning Map of the Development Regulations from Commercial-General (GC) to Mixed-Development (MD).

The intention of this amendment is to provide Council with the authority to consider the expansion of the main building at 5 Centennial Street (Wilkin's Automotive Repairs) to increase the number of service bays to six. This amendment is brought forward by the property owner of 5 Centennial Street.

Anyone wishing to make an objection or representation at the Public Hearing shall, at least 2 days before the date set for the Public Hearing, deposit with the CAO, two copies of a signed written statement outlining the objection or representation.
