PLANNING AND LAND USE DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

12-12-839 Professional Medical Building – 48 Bannister Street

Motion - Councillor Aker/Councillor Ledwell

RESOLVED THAT a development permit be issued to Performance, Stability, Rehabilitation Ltd. and GNA Properties Inc. to develop Clinic and Office Uses within the existing building at 48 Bannister Street, subject to:

- i. The development being exempted from the off-street parking requirements of the Mount Pearl Development Regulations 2010, as this is one of a series of attached older buildings along Bannister Street without off-street parking;
- all occupancies of buildings within the City requiring an Occupancy Permit prior to the occupancy of the building with a final inspection being required to ensure compliance to all regulations, codes and requirements prior to issuance of an Occupancy Permit;

- iii. notwithstanding the requirements as per Section 8 Signs and Advertisements of the City of Mount Pearl Development Regulations 2010, signs for buildings housing two or more uses or occupancy shall be limited to one wall sign per use or occupancy and one pylon or ground sign per street frontage for the whole building; such pylon or ground sign shall display the advertisement for all uses or occupancies housed in the building;
- iv. meeting of all City Inspector conditions; and,
- v. meeting all requirements of the Mount Pearl Development Regulations 2010.
