3.	The Applicant must provide written verifi local supplier to the City's Infrastructure permit.										
4.	A maximum of four, half-inch garden hoses may be connected to the hydrant. All hoses to have individual spray nozzles which automatically shut off when released.										
5.	The Applicant will be held responsible for any damages caused to City owned or public property. This includes the fire hydrant being used.										
6.	The Applicant must obtain permission from the property owner where the car wash is to be held.										
7.	An adult must be present at all times to supervise any minor group having a car wash.										
8.	The City shall have the right to turn off the hydrant at any time, (ie., in the case of emergency, abuse of the hydrant or misuse of water).										
9.	A copy of this permit <u>must</u> be posted at the site at all times.
