This permit is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. **The hydrant will be operated by a member of the City’s Infrastructure & Public Works/UTM Division. Please contact (709)748-1016 to coordinate hydrant use/connection and disconnection.**
- 2. **The Applicant is responsible to provide a Double Backflow Preventer and Hydrant Connections. This equipment is necessary to control water flow from the hydrant. Equipment to be inspected by the City’s Infrastructure & Public Works/UTM Division.**
- 3. **If the Company does not own required equipment, the Applicant must provide written verification of required equipment, (see item #2) from a local supplier to the City’s Infrastructure & Public Works/UTM Division prior to obtaining a permit.**
- 4. A maximum of four, half-inch garden hoses may be connected to the hydrant. All hoses to have individual spray nozzles which automatically shut off when released.
- 5. The Applicant will be held responsible for any damages caused to City owned or public property. This includes the fire hydrant being used.
- 6. If a private hydrant is to be used, the Applicant must obtain permission from the property owner.
- 7. The City shall have the right to turn off the hydrant at any time, (i.e. in the case of emergency, abuse of the hydrant or misuse of water).
- 8. A copy of this permit must be posted at the site at all times. The permit form is available from City Hall, 3 Centennial Street, Mount Pearl, NL; the Infrastructure & Public Works/UTM Division located at the H. Neil Windsor Municipal Building, 59 Clyde Avenue or from the City’s website: [www.mountpearl.ca](http://www.mountpearl.ca).
- 9. In the event of water shortages or reduced pond levels, the City reserves the right to cancel permits previously issued.
