

Fence Property Damage Policy

1.0 Policy Statement

The City of Mount Pearl will conduct an inspection and assessment for cases of vandalism and private property damage adjacent to City-owned trails. All instances must be reported to the Department of Infrastructure and Public Works, and procedures must be followed. Coverage of damage by the City, if considered, will include materials cost only.

2.0 Purpose

To provide a set of guidelines for instances of vandalism on private property adjacent City-owned trails.

3.0 Procedure

- After vandalism occurs, it must be reported immediately to the Department of Infrastructure and Public Works during normal business hours. Vandalism or property damage can include graffiti, and physical damage to fence.
- An inspection must be done of the current fencing (i.e. photos, condition, location).
- Repair can include painting and/or replacement of fence.
- The owner will be responsible to purchase the materials necessary to repair the damage, and a copy of the original invoice submitted to the Public Works Division for payment.
- The owner must complete the repair.
