

Supplemental Signs Policy

1.0 Policy Statement

The City of Mount Pearl is responsible for the installation and approval of signs that provide notice, warning or information to the general public. The City of Mount Pearl shall install supplemental signs with the goal of advising the public of unusual or unexpected conditions in a way that is strategic and efficient.

2.0 Background

All signs installed within the City must serve a specific informational purpose for the public at large such as a notification of a Metro Bus Stop. Signs that are requested by residents for special reasons must be approved by City Council.

3.0 Scope

This policy applies to City informational signs, and requests received from the public to install signs. It excludes traffic related signs.


4.0 Purpose

To establish a Policy for the City of Mount Pearl that outlines the guidelines for establishing supplemental signs while at the same time encouraging the uniform application of supplemental signs.

5.0 Definition

- **Supplemental Signs** – Signs that typically are not considered standard traffic signs and include special directional or informational signs approved for the purposes of the municipality.
