

Traffic Signs Policy

1.0 Policy Statement

The City of Mount Pearl is responsible for the installation of traffic signs that provide notice, warning or information to the public. The City of Mount Pearl will use traffic signs that are listed and conform with the Canadian Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices, and the Transportation Association of Canada. The City shall install traffic signs with the goal of advising motorists of unusual or unexpected road conditions in a way that is strategic and efficient. This policy applies only to traffic signs and excludes other City informational and supplemental signs.


2.0 Background

All traffic signs installed within City boundaries must conform with Transportation Association of Canada (TAC) and the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Canada (MUTCDC). The City will look at regular and selective enforcement measures.

3.0 Purpose

To establish a Policy for the City of Mount Pearl that outlines the guidelines to be followed by the City when erecting approved traffic signs and to ensure that only standardized and approved traffic signs are erected.
