

## Alcohol Use at the Annex Policy

### 1.0 Policy Statement

The City of Mount Pearl promotes a safe, enjoyable environment within City facilities and it is committed to encouraging the growth of arts, culture and heritage in the community. Rentals of the Annex for non-alcoholic events by outside groups are permitted. Events involving alcoholic beverages shall only be permitted for business events hosted by the Association for the Arts of Mount Pearl, the Admiralty House Communications Museum and the City of Mount Pearl. Renters are required to comply with the guidelines established by this policy.

### 2.0 Scope

This policy applies to rentals and events at The Annex involving alcohol.

### 3.0 Purpose


To establish the boundaries for alcohol during events at the Annex.

### 4.0 Alcohol Guidelines

The following terms shall apply:

- I. Only the City of Mount Pearl, Admiralty House Communications Museum, and AAMP are permitted to serve alcohol at an event held in the Annex for business purposes.
- II. Any alcoholic beverage containers must be removed from the premises at the end of each rental period.
- III. The renter is responsible for the conduct of his/her guests.
