In this winter scene there are 10 differences between the pictures. Can you find them all?





SNOW SCIENCE

Try out some of these wintery science experiments. Make sure to have an adult help out.

SNOW CANDY

In a pot on the stove, heat up your favourite maple syrup, stirring occasionally.

Let it boil for five minutes.

Pour the hot syrup on clean snow or ice. Roll the candy up on a popsicle stick and **enjoy the sweet treat!**



COLOURED SNOW SCULPTURES

Build your favourite character, animal, or person out of snow in your yard.

Fill a waterbottle with water. Add a few drops of food colouring or even drink crystals. Spray where you'd like to add colour and transform your snow sculptures.

Experiment with the spray and stream options to make your colours more or less intense.

FROZEN BUBBLES

Choose a less windy day where the temperature is well below zero.

Use a bubble solution or create your own with one part water, four parts dish soap.

Blow your bubbles softly so they land on a hard surface and watch your bubbles turn into crystal balls!



WINTER SAFETY TIPS

Getting out to play in winter is fun and healthy, but only if you play it safe.

REMEMBER:

- Play well away from the roads. Backyards are perfect for building snowmen and snow sculptures.
- Snow plows like Safey are big and take extra time to stop, so give them plenty of space.
- Wear bright clothing so drivers can see you playing.
- Take a hot chocolate break indoors when you get too cold or wet!
- When sliding, always ride on your knees or backside, and face forward. Slide one at a time to avoid banging into another sleder.
- Playing in the snow is more fun with a buddy! Play with a friend and look out for each other.
