

## Contractor Health and Safety Policy

### 1.0 Policy Statement

Contractors shall adhere to the terms in this policy and cooperate with the City of Mount Pearl in its efforts to maintain the health and safety for all parties. Contractors working on City property will establish and maintain health and safety practices by taking every precaution reasonable to: protect the health and safety of the City and contractor employees and the general public; and to minimize corporate and individual liability throughout the duration of the contract.

### 2.0 Regulatory Requirements

Contractors who perform work for the City of Mount Pearl shall comply with the Occupational Health and Safety Act and related regulations and City policies.

### 3.0 Purpose

To ensure the effective application of contractor health and safety requirements to control operational risks, fulfill the OH&S policy and OH&S objectives, and conform to the Occupational Health and Safety Act and Regulations.

### 4.0 Scope

This procedure applies to all contracts for services undertaken for the City on City of Mount Pearl property or authorized by City of Mount Pearl personnel.

### 5.0 Related Procedures

Refer to City's companion document *Contractor Health and Safety Procedure*.

**Non-compliance to this policy may result in termination of the contract.**
