The city recognizes that disruption during a job action period can be frustrating.

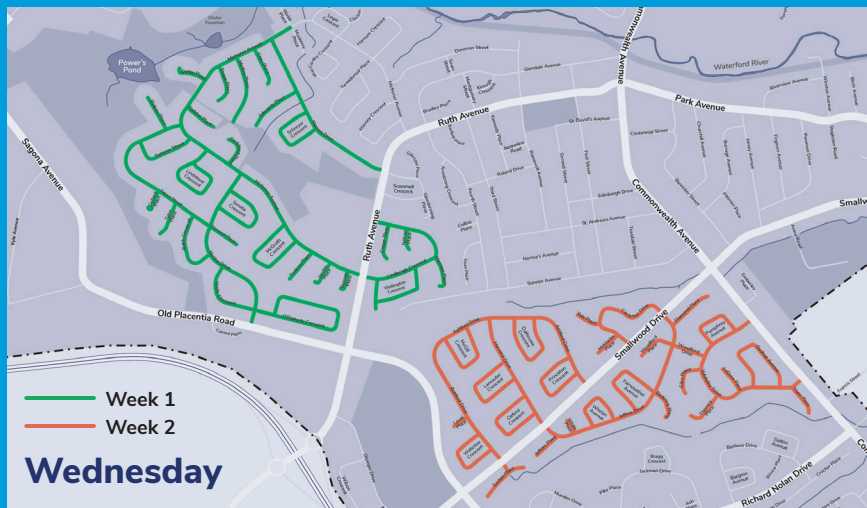
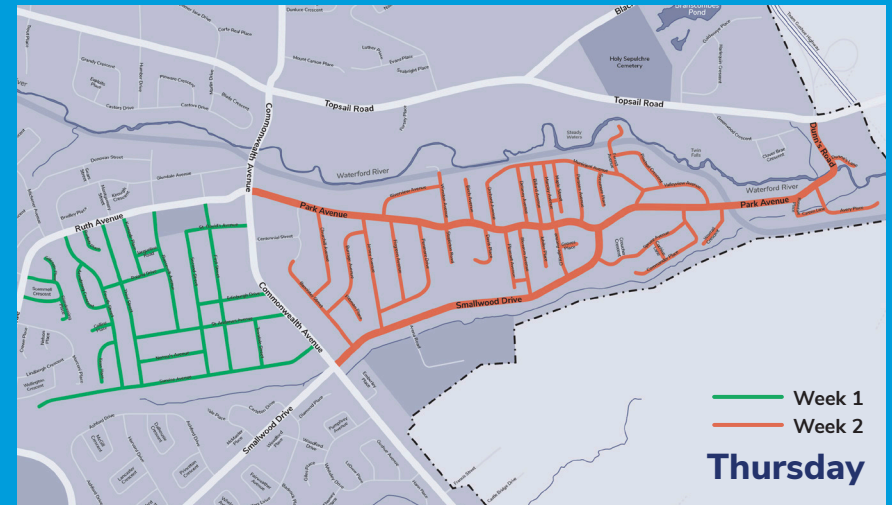
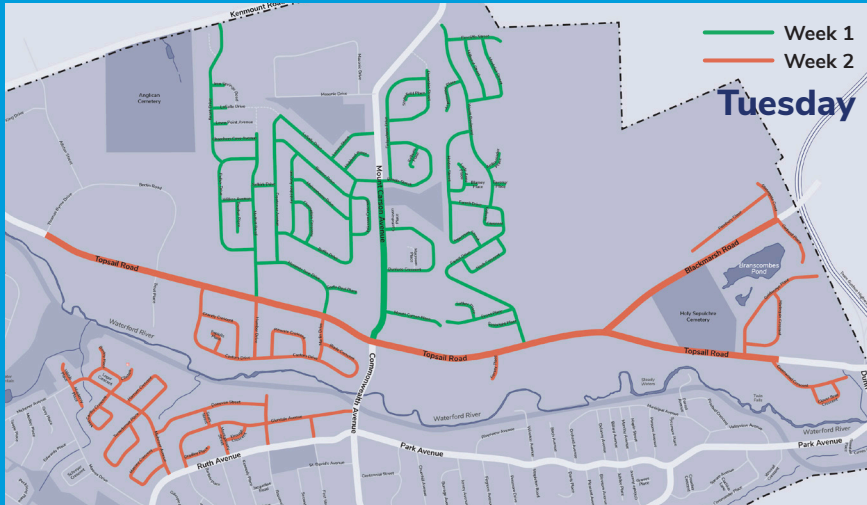
