Mount Pearl Delivers \$80,000 in Annual Sporting Grants

Mount Pearl, NL – On April 18th, the City of Mount Pearl approved \$80,000 in annual sporting community grants to youth sporting associations in the city. The grants are distributed directly by the city to thirteen sporting associations with membership in the Mount Pearl Sport Alliance.

“Mount Pearl is rooted in community, and our minor sporting associations are at the centre of that community”, said Mayor Dave Aker. “As a Council, we know that sports represent an opportunity for youth to be engaged in our community through healthy activities, and we want to continue to support that.”

The annual distribution of the grant funds takes into consideration factors such as participation in the alliance, registration numbers, and operating expenses for sporting groups.

“The City of Mount Pearl has a long history of supporting the minor sports community”, continued Mayor Aker. “Sporting groups create opportunities for respectful, friendly, and fun competition through tournaments and athletic events for residents.”
