ST. DAVID'S PARK

One of the largest parks in the city, St. David's Park is located off St. David's Avenue. It features a cenotaph war memorabile, surrounded with a seating area and bubblers, as well as a smart accessible playground, complete with smart technology, accessible rubber surface and the addition of two new gender-neutral washrooms. There is also a pavilion, oval walking track, life-sized chess board, and compass rose in the centre of the park.

WINTER GROOMED TRAILS

Throughout the winter months, the city grooms areas of its trail system for walking, snowshoeing and cross-country skiing.

COMMUNITY GARDENS

With over 50 community garden beds operated by various groups throughout the city, these gardens provide residents the opportunity to grow fresh, healthy and affordable food.
