The donation of \$11,745 will be officially presented during the next public council meeting on November 12, 2024. This Halloween-themed "spooktacular," held from October 18 to 27, 2024, attracted crowds from across the Avalon Peninsula and showcased the community's enduring spirit of generosity.

The funds raised will be evenly divided among three local food banks, each receiving \$3,915 to help continue their vital work in the community:
