City of Mount Pearl Launches Community Safety and Well-Being Survey

Mount Pearl, NL – Since hosting a Community Conversation on Public Safety held in December, the City of Mount Pearl has been working diligently to develop a Community Safety and Well-Being (CSWB) Plan — and today, residents are invited to help shape that plan with the launch of a safety survey.

"We're developing a Community Safety and Well-Being Plan, and your input is essential," said Mayor Dave Aker. "The first step is a community assessment, where we invite residents to share their experiences, perspectives, and ideas. Our goal is to make Mount Pearl a place where everyone feels safe, supported, and connected."

The CSWB Plan will focus on actions the City can take to:

- Prevent crime and support safer neighbourhoods
- Create safer public spaces, including trails and parks
- Collaborate with police, service providers, and the community to build a safer city
